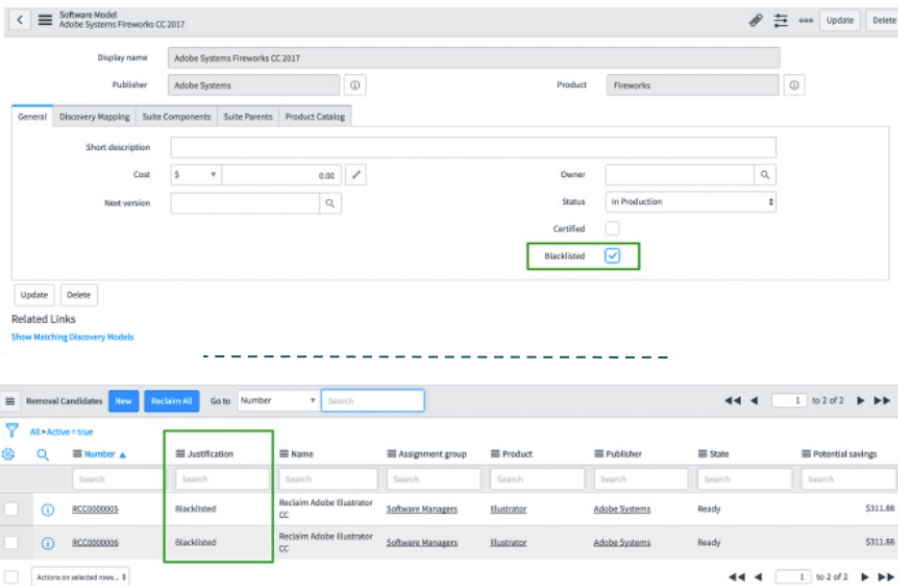


# Restricted Software Lists

Do you know what software is lurking in your corporate environment?

## What is restricted software?

It is common for employees to have software on their corporate issued devices that is intended for personal use. Companies often have a list of software that is prohibited to be installed on the corporate network. Unauthorized software on the corporate domain can lead to software compliance issues, introduce potential vulnerabilities, and potentially expose the company to HR and PR transgressions.



With Software Asset Management Restricted Software lists, customers can identify what types of software they do not wish to permit according to something that may be in appropriate per corporate policy, or introduce unnecessary risk into the environment.
